Format	Liquid. Purified antibody supplied in 1x PBS buffer with 0.09% (w/v) sodium azide and 2% sucrose.
Reconstitution & Storage	Add 100 ul of distilled water. Final anti-STAT5B antibody concentration is 1 mg/ml in PBS buffer with 2% sucrose. For longer periods of storage, store at 20°C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw cycles.
Precautions	STAT5B antibody - middle region is for research use only and not for use in diagnostic or therapeutic procedures.

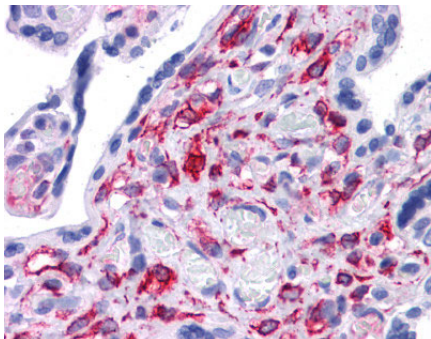
Protein Information

Name	Stat5b
Function	Carries out a dual function: signal transduction and activation of transcription. Mediates cellular responses to the cytokine KITLG/SCF and other growth factors. Binds to the GAS element and activates PRL-induced transcription. Positively regulates hematopoietic/erythroid differentiation.
Cellular Location	Cytoplasm. Nucleus. Note=Translocated into the nucleus in response to phosphorylation
Tissue Location	In the virgin, found in most tissues. Particularly abundant in muscle tissue of virgin and lactating females, and of males.

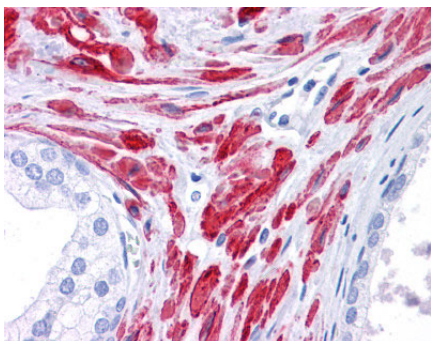

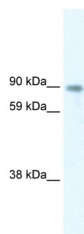
