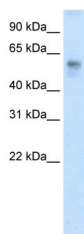

Synonyms	KIAA0952
Function	Acts as a key regulator of dendritic field orientation during development of sensory cortex. Also directs dendrites toward active axon terminals when ectopically expressed (By similarity).
Cellular Location	Cytoplasm, cytosol. Nucleus. Note=Translocates from the cytosol to the nucleus in response to neuronal activity.

Reconstitution and Storage: For short term use, store at 2-8C up to 1 week. For long term storage, store at -20C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.
