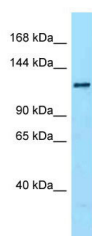

Name	Dennd1a
Function	Guanine nucleotide exchange factor (GEF) regulating clathrin- mediated endocytosis through RAB35 activation. Promotes the exchange of GDP to GTP, converting inactive GDP-bound RAB35 into its active GTP- bound form. Regulates clathrin-mediated endocytosis of synaptic vesicles and mediates exit from early endosomes (PubMed: 17182770 , PubMed: 20159556). Binds phosphatidylinositol-phosphates (PtdInsPs), with some preference for PtdIns(3)P (PubMed: 20159556).
Cellular Location	Cytoplasmic vesicle, clathrin-coated vesicle membrane; Peripheral membrane protein. Presynaptic cell membrane. Note=Associates to membranes via lipid-binding activity.
