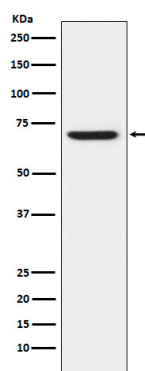

Immunogen	A synthesized peptide derived from human GABA A Receptor alpha 5
Description	GABA, the major inhibitory neurotransmitter in the vertebrate brain, mediates neuronal inhibition by binding to the GABA/benzodiazepine receptor and opening an integral chloride channel.
Storage Condition and Buffer	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline , pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol. Store at +4°C short term. Store at -20°C long term. Avoid freeze / thaw cycle.

Function	Alpha subunit of the heteropentameric ligand-gated chloride channel gated by gamma-aminobutyric acid (GABA), a major inhibitory neurotransmitter in the brain (PubMed: 14993607 , PubMed: 29961870 , PubMed: 30140029 , PubMed: 31056671). GABA-gated chloride channels, also named GABA(A) receptors (GABAAAR), consist of five subunits arranged around a central pore and contain GABA active binding site(s) located at the alpha and beta subunit interface(s) (PubMed: 30140029). When activated by GABA, GABAAARs selectively allow the flow of chloride anions across the cell membrane down their electrochemical gradient (PubMed: 14993607 , PubMed: 30140029). GABAAARs containing alpha-5/GABRA5 subunits are mainly extrasynaptic and contribute to the tonic GABAergic inhibition in the hippocampus (By similarity). Extrasynaptic alpha-5- containing GABAAARs in CA1 pyramidal neurons play a role in learning and memory processes (By similarity).
