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<b>Shipping Condition</b>	Wet Ice
<b>Application Note</b>	Mouse Secondary antibody conjugates are ideal for western blotting, Immunohistochemistry and ELISA as well as other antibody detection methods.
<b>Purity</b>	Mouse Secondary Antibody was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Mouse IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Alkaline Phosphatase (calf intestine), anti-Goat Serum, Mouse IgG and Mouse Serum. No reaction was observed against Bovine, Chicken, Goat, Guinea Pig, Hamster, Horse, Human, Rabbit, Rat and Sheep Serum Proteins.
<b>Storage Condition</b>	Store secondary antibody at 4° C before opening. DO NOT FREEZE. Conjugated antibody is stable at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. Freezing alkaline phosphatase conjugates will result in a substantial loss of enzymatic activity.
<b>Precautions Note</b>	This product is for research use only and is not intended for therapeutic or diagnostic applications.

## Background

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Conjugated Secondary Antibodies are ideal for western blot and are available in a variety of formats and conjugate types. When choosing a secondary antibody, consideration must be given to species and immunoglobulin specificity, conjugate type, fragment and chain specificity, level of cross-reactivity, and host-species source and fragment composition.
